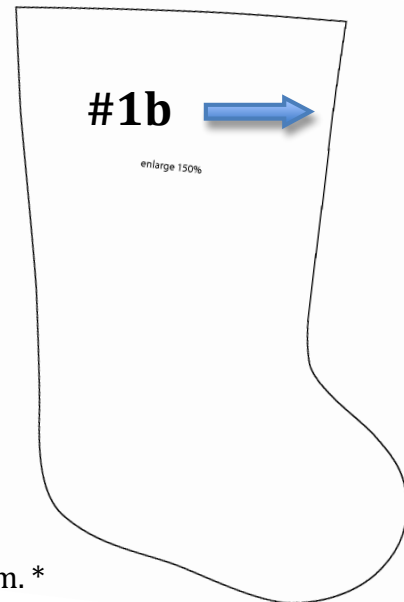

View Examples & Read Directions (***) *Some* steps must be done correctly or will need to be redone.)
Student will evaluate on a scale of 1-5, 5 being the best.

____ **Step #1: (View Example)**

- Place stocking pieces right sides together.*
- Pin 4" from top front of stocking.
- Stitch a 3/8" seam allowance, 4" from top of stocking.
- Backstitch to secure seam.
- Press seam to one side.



____ **Step #2: (View Example)**

- Fold (folded) band in half to find middle.
- Pin middle of band right sides together at stocking seam.*
- Continue to pin band to stocking from middle outward.
- Fold band end to wrong side to match

raw edge of stocking.*

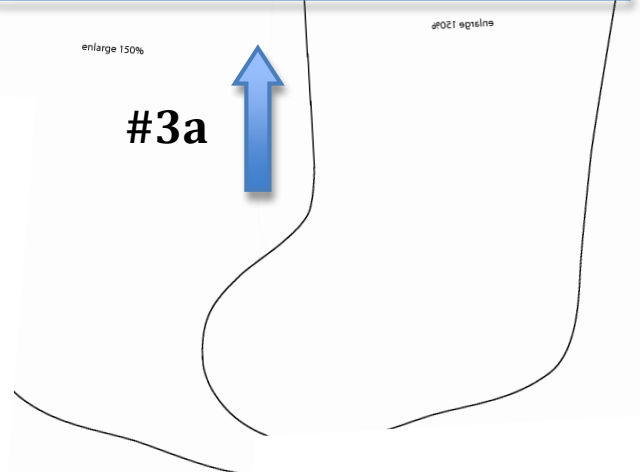

____ **Step #3: (View Example)**

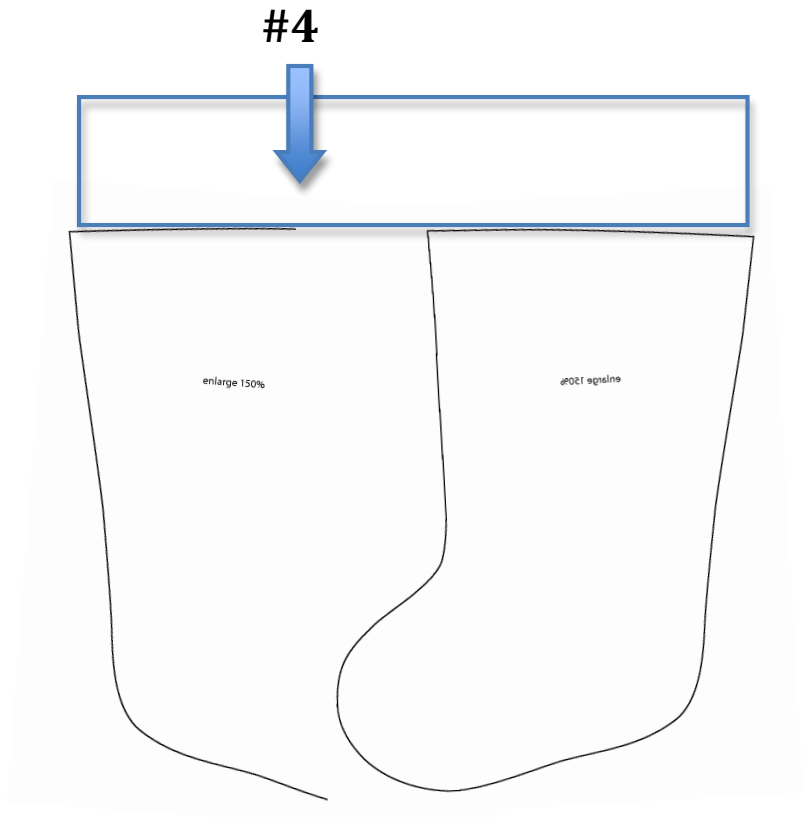
- Sew 1/2" seam allowance.
- Backstitch to secure seam.



c. Press seam allowance towards stocking band, away from stocking.

____ **Step #4: (View Example)**

On right side of stocking, topstitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " from band edge along stocking.



____ **Step #5: (View Example)**

- a. Pin stocking right sides together. *
- b. Begin sewing at front of stocking, where the 4" seam ended.
- c. Continue sewing around stocking with a $\frac{3}{8}$ " seam allowance, as you approach the folded edges of the band start to taper to within 1" of the end of the band and backstitch as if you were making a dart. *

This will leave an opening for the drawstring.
