## All pre-professional students must meet the following requirements for admission to the program:

- Maintain a 2.5 cumulative OSU GPA
- Receive a C- or better in all courses within major
- Complete: MTH 111, WR 121, and COMM 111/114/218
- Satisfactory completion of pre-professional courses in major (listed below)
- Complete at least 45 credits of course work at OSU before the first term in the professional program (Transfer credits: 15 OSU & 30 credits transferred from accredited institution).
- No more than three courses may be in progress at time of application and acceptance; acceptance is provisionally granted based on completion of these courses.
- Students will not be permitted to take professional coursework without acceptance to professional program.
- Students must be declared as pre-professional students in the major to apply to professional program.
- The annual deadline for application materials to the professional program is **APRIL 7th**.
