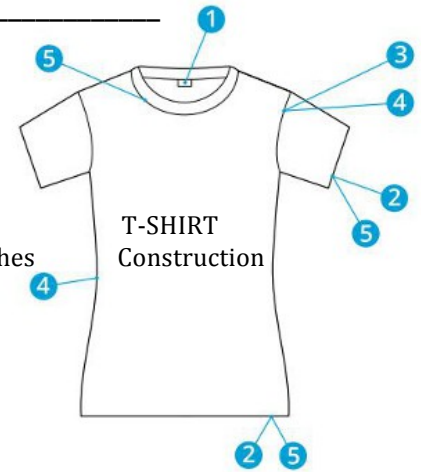
Textile 2 - Knit Project: T-Shirt

Materials:

- Pattern and/or sample tee shirt.
- Knit Fabric
- Twill Tape for shoulders.
- Ribbing and/or Facing for neck.
- Thread

Equipment:

- Sewing Machine with stretch stitches
- Serger with 4-Thread Overlock
- Twin Needle (optional)
- Cover Stitch (optional)

1. **Cutting Layout:** OK'ed by teacher _____
On grain, neatly cut including notches, markings on wrong side of fabric. _____
2. **Shoulder Seams:** Right sides together, 5/8" seam, Serge to reinforced and apply twill tape to strengthen. (**Raglan sleeve** seams don't need twill tape.) _____
3. **Sleeve Seams:** Right sides together, even 5/8", neatly Serged. (Illustration #3&4) _____
4. **Side Seams:** Right sides together, Plaid / strips & underarm seam match at seam. even 5/8", neatly Serged. (Illustration #3&4) _____
5. **Crew, "V" Neck:** Ribbing or Facing attached as demonstrated. Seam at back of neck. Stitched evenly & serged evenly. (Illus. #5) _____
6. **Tag/Optional Topstitching:** shoulder, neck &/or sleeve seams. (Illus. #1) _____
7. **Hem or Ribbing:** Serge raw edge. Turn to wrong side 3/4" - 1". Sew over serged edge an even distance from hem edge with Cover Stitch or large Stretch Stitch. (Illustration #2&5) _____
8. **Pressing:** Overall neatness, threads clipped, pressed & folded. _____
9. **Neatness:** Overall neatness, threads clipped. Markings do not show on outside of garment. NO holes _____
