Practice respectful, responsible, safe behavior as explained in the “OCHS Positive Behavior” Matrix in your student planner on page 7.

## Cleanliness:

No food or beverages (except H2O bottles) are allowed in the classroom.

The last class of the day, in Room E109, is responsible for putting their chairs up on the table.

The last class of the day, in Room E113, is responsible for powering off the computer.

Start clean-up **5 min.** prior to the end of class.

Class clean-up supervision assignments correlate to Sewing Machine/Computer assignments.

## Communication:

For your success and safety, LISTEN to all instruction!

Electronic Devices are to be turned off and put away during this class period. The use of **electronic devices**, prevents the student from being fully engaged, and also is a safety hazard in the sewing lab. Infractions will result in a referral and loss of participation in class activities." If you have an emergency and/or need to use your device for a class assignment, get teacher permission prior to using your device.

## Punctuality:

Students are expected to be in their assigned seat when class starts (refer to bell schedule).

Tardies are a disruption, enter quietly and present teacher with admit notice.

## Respect:

Speak kindly to and of each other.

Care for equipment, supplies and the facility.
